









DAY 2	Tashkent- Nukus <i>Nukus, city in western Uzbekistan, capital of the Karakalpakstan Autonomous Republic, in the delta of the Amu Darya River. Nukus is about 1255 km west of Tashkent, and about 230 km south of Muynaq and the former shoreline of the Aral Sea. An increase in upstream irrigation needs reduced the downstream flow of the Amu Darya, contributing to the shrinking of the Aral and the disappearance of its plentiful fish stock..</i>	05:30 06:00	<b>Early Breakfast</b> <b>Transfer to Airport for flight HY 1001 to Nukus.</b> <b>Arriving at 09:45</b>  <b>Accommodation at hotel.</b>  <b>City tour. Free time at leisure <b>Short city tour</b> <b>Dinner</b> at Lyabi Hauz-a cozy pond in the center of the ancient part where people come together for having a drink and dinner. One of places where you can see the real Uzbek life.</p>	

<p>DAY 6</p>	<p>Bukhara <i>Ancient and fairy-tale town of Bukhara - the land of magical lamps and Eastern beauties. Ancient Great Silk Road caravans never missed this town - the only oasis around. Arriving Samarkand  <b>Lunch</b> at famous Nur Ata legendary mystery Complex Accommodation at Yurtas in the middle of Kyzil-Kum desert. Free time at leisure. Ridding camels with professional trainers. Exploring flora and fauna of Yangi kazgan Music show of local musicians, famous Kazakh and Kyrgyz songs. <b>Dinner</b> Overnight in Yurt</p>

Siyab local bazaar-unique place where you can get acquainted with the life of Samarkand people. Shahi - Zinda necropolises, a holy place and cemetery with graves of Temured’s dynasty and a grave of cousin of Prophet Muhamed. Quick shopping of water melons and melons.</p> <p>Arriving Tashent</p> <p><b>Lunch</b> at local restaurant. Tasting different cuisine of Central Asian nations.
